Finally, at the end of the month I visited the Rotary Club of Salemi which has inaugurated its new premises and where I met with the youngsters from the Rotaract and Interact Clubs.

Allow me to remind you once more of the theme of the month, which is the internal and external expansion of Rotary. We shall expand on this theme during the seminar being held on the 22<sup>nd</sup> September during the "Festa dell'Amicizia".

Rotary International has set as an objective for the period 2012-2015 the increase of membership from 1.2 million to 1.3 million members. Personally I believe that, rather than increasing the number of members, we need to work harder to retain our current members improving their loyalty towards Rotary.

This work is, moreover, in line with one of the objectives of R.I.'s Strategic Plan, which is that of sustaining and reinforcing Clubs, promoting innovation and membership diversity, encouraging Club members to undertake service activities, developing new leaders and creating new and more dynamic clubs.

Well, I believe that one of the main causes of members abandoning their Clubs is the shortage of service activities. Often we rely on words, at most putting our hands into our pockets and wallets, without then moving onto action.

We neglect our "mission": WE ARE A GLOBAL NETWORK OF MOTIVATED PEOPLE WHO DEDICATE OURSELVES WITH ENTHUSIASM TO SOCIAL CAUSES WITH THE OBJECTIVE OF IMPROVING LIFE IN THE COMMUNITY.
