Dear fellow Rotarians,

The month of March is dedicated to Water and Hygiene. This is an area of vital importance for the survival and the wellbeing of humanity. It therefore receives special attention from Rotary with numberless initiatives. Our District too has taken important steps in favour of this area. Among these I wish to mention: The Rotarian Charter relating to Water which was the outcome of much work by the Italy-Tunisia inter-nation committee which took place last October in Mazara del Vallo; the programme called 'Gigi and Water' which was an educational and informative programme with the production of a brochure which was distributed amongst thousands of schoolchildren and students; the various club projects in collaboration with RF in favour of the deprived areas of the globe.

March also sees Rotaract yearly week which this year falls between 7 and 13 March. This event stimulates the getting closer to our young partners in service, we must never forget that Rotaract is a programme that each Rotary Club must responsibly follow avoiding to disappoint our young ones who trust us and have chosen Rotary as a step towards their development in the area of service to others.
